Project Purpose

To build additional partners in C4, implement structures for communication and collaboration within and across communities, and implement specific equitable climate projects.

Key Lessons Learned

- 1. Be prepared to provide additional support as under-resourced and small communities have limited bandwidth.
- 2. Sufficient staff support and partners to do intensive work is essential.
- 3. Utilize peer accountability to drive action. Strong mayoral leadership is a bonus.
- 4. Sharing backgrounds and stories can lead to an increased appreciation among team members and discussions about overall approach to working within BIPOC/LMI communities.
